Award Requirements

This award is designed to recognize a company Superintendent or Manager whose job is not primarily safety related, but rather jobsite management. The company CEO/President must nominate an individual for this award. The duties must be performed for Florida operations for a member company. In order to qualify, the nominee has to have displayed positive efforts in safety, improvement in safety performance and involved others in their commitment to safety on the job.

Application

1. Submit evidence or description of safety and/or incident record for projects under the supervision of nominee. No willful OSHA citations under the candidate's supervision.
2. Describe how this individual has displayed commitment to safety and health and involved others in that commitment on projects.
3. Describe other contributions nominee has made to the safety of the jobsite or the company.
4. Submission of electronic photos is recommended but not required and should be included on your application.
5. Please submit a maximum of a two-page summary supporting why your candidate should be considered for this award. You must include, but are not limited to the following:
 - Safety Leadership (i.e. project recognition programs, discipline programs, orientation program, etc.)
 - Description of candidate's effective safety practices.
 - Safety Training that is project specific.
 - Safety Certifications and/or Awards.
 - Safety Leadership (i.e. project recognition programs, discipline programs, orientation program, etc.)
6. Description of candidate's effective safety practices.
7. Describe the type of supervision activities, to include subcontractor activities.
