Completed Applications Due: Friday March 31, 2017 by 5:00 p.m.

The safety profession is made up of men and women who have devoted their careers making our workplaces safer. Some safety professionals go far and above the call of duty in their devotion to preserving quality of life in the workforce. Many go far above and beyond the borders of their employer, distinguishing him or her by giving back to the industry. This very prestigious award exemplifies the most dedicated and innovative professionals and their active participation in the advancement of the safety management process both within their company and in the construction industry. This is an opportunity for the safety professional to be recognized by their company senior management in nomination and by their peers in achieving this award.

General Rules

1. The company CEO or president must nominate candidates for this award.
2. A nominee for this award must devote at least 50% of his or her duties to Safety and Health.
3. Candidate's duties must be performed for Florida operations for a member company and a member company must employ the candidate at the time of nomination and award. The member company must be in good standing for 2015 and 2016.
4. Eligible candidates may not have received this award in the past five years.
5. All application of nomination packages for award must be complete and submitted in a tabbed binder with the following sections:

Section 1: Narrative

2. Length of time as a Safety Professional, include history covering past 10 years or more. You may provide a resume for this element or a description.

4. Participation in professional safety related organizations, seminars or activities.
5. Brief overview of the company's safety program and nominee's involvement in its creation and implementation. Include highlights or exemplary accomplishments.
6. New programs developed and implemented by nominee.
7. Nominee improvements in company's safety record or programs under nominee's leadership.
8. Leadership traits that have contributed to nominee's success as Safety Director, illustrate with example(s).
9. Special professional accomplishments in construction safety and contributions to the construction industry (include publications, presentations, memberships, speeches, etc.)
